Borrelia MENONIII

Mayo Clinic researchers in Minnesota, North Dakota and Wisconsin, have discovered a new bacterial species that causes Lyme disease in people, Borrelia mayonii. This bacteria causes an illness that appears to be associated with nausea and vomiting, diffuse rashes (rather than a single bull's-eye rash), and a higher concentration of bacteria in the blood.
