Borrelia Garinii

Borrelia garinii is a Lyme disease causing spirochete, known to be prevalent throughout Europe. In 2006, the CDC published a study confirming the presence of B. garinii in ticks carried by seabirds on the eastern shores of North America. B. garinii is known to not produce an EM rash. It has shown to be a causative factor of Lyme neuroborreliosis.
